### Four new partnerships for inclusive insurance

The ILO continues to push the frontiers of insurance with four new partners. Our new partnership with the [Munich Climate Insurance Initiative](#) will focus on climate insurance in the Caribbean. In partnership with [AXA](#), we will design and deliver insurance innovations to benefit low-income workers, especially women and migrants, in Indonesia. Our partnership with the [Ford Foundation](#) will support the extension of a national crop insurance scheme to excluded farmers in India. Finally, in partnership with [FSD Kenya](#), we will support the National Health Insurance Fund as it embarks on new efforts to extend its health insurance package to informal sector workers and their families in Kenya.
